2. APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUMBLE AND TRIPLE B SERVICES, LLP FOR THE 2016 CONCRETE PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,179,125.50.

City Manager Boeske recommended approval of the contract.

Mayor Aaron invited Kevin and Joseph Burke to speak on behalf of Triple B Construction. Mr. Burke informed the Council that Triple B would like to hold a town hall style meeting before work beings to discuss the project and timeline and meet with the residents in the affected area.
