

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-808**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE,  
TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY  
MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON AUGUST 27, 2017 IN RESPONSE TO  
HURRICANE HARVEY.**

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2017, the Mayor of the City of Humble, Texas, (the "City") issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City, in response to the anticipated loss of life and damage to property threatened by conditions resulting from Hurricane Harvey, and

WHEREAS, the City suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from Hurricane Harvey; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE,  
TEXAS:**

Section 1. The declaration of disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on August 27, 2017, shall be renewed and continued through September 14, 2017, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.
