RESOLUTION NO. 17-779

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A SURPLUS FIRE APPARATUS TO THE LONE STAR COLLEGE KINGWOOD CAMPUS FIRE SCIENCE PROGRAM, FINDING THE CONVEYANCE SERVES A PUBLIC PURPOSE, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO TRANSFER TITLE AND CONVEY THE VEHCILE TO THE COLLEGE.

- WHEREAS, The City owns a 1999 Ford F-350 Super Duty Cascade truck utilized for firefighter and emergency response services, and
- WHEREAS, The City finds that the above stated apparatus has reached the conclusion of its useful service life as a front line and reserve apparatus for the Humble Fire Department and is surplus property; and
- WHEREAS, Lone Star College, another local government of the State of Texas, offers a workforce development program for Fire Science Technologies, which provides the necessary education and training for students to complete the Texas Commission on Fire Protection state exam, and
- WHEREAS, Lone Star College's Fire Science Program's success depends upon providing its students with training on various fire equipment and apparatus; and
- WHEREAS, The City finds that the Lone Star College Fire Science Program serves a public purpose and that the Fire Science Program would benefit from the transfer of the above stated apparatus from the City to the Program, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE TEXAS THAT:

- Section 1. The 1999 Ford F-350 Super Duty Cascade truck shall be transferred to the Lone Star College for use at the Kingwood Campus Fire Science Program
- Section 2. The Mayor and City Manager are authorized to execute a contract and any and all documents necessary to transfer title and convey the apparatus to the College
- Section 3. The Used Property Agreement between the City of Humble, Texas and Lone Star College Kingwood attached hereto is made part of this resolution as fully as if set out at length herein.
- Section 3 That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage
