RESOLUTION NO. 18-795

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE SAN JACINTO RIVER AUTHORITY'S APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD FOR A FLOOD PROTECTION GRANT

WHEREAS, the San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) is coordinating with entities in the San Jacinto River Basin to submit an application to the Texas Water Development Board for a grant to conduct a Flood Protection Planning Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed planning would benefit areas within the West Fork and Spring Creek watersheds all the way to Lake Houston through two separate studies – one to assess the feasibility of a flood control reservoir in the Spring Creek watershed and another to develop a Lake Conroe predictive tool to supplement SJRA's gate operations plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed planning does not duplicate existing projects with the exception of updating existing flood protection planning information and upgrading an existing hydrologic monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Humble desires to work with SJRA to pursue implementation of viable solutions identified through the proposed planning effort and will pursue and identify potential sources of funding for implementation of viable solutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE TEXAS:


Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas does hereby support the SJRA application to the Texas Water Development Board for flood protection planning grant assistance.

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas urges all community leaders, businesses, organizations and residents to submit letters of support to the Texas Water Development Board for this important endeavor.

Section 3: That the City Secretary is authorized to submit on behalf of the City of Humble a certified copy of this Resolution to the San Jacinto River Authority and to the Chairperson of the Texas Water Development Board.


